Secret Dalemain

An in-depth look at one of Cumbria's oldest family homes. Join our specialist guide and hear the stories of those who lived and worked at Dalemain in the Victorian and Edwardian eras. This tour includes access to unseen areas of the House, along with fresh tea and scones served in the Mediaeval Hall tearoom. This tour generally lasts two hours, and includes a brief introduction to Dalemain's beautiful Historic Gardens.

Dalemain to Dacre

Combine your visit to Dalemain with a trip to the nearby village of Dacre to visit the beautiful and historic Church of Saint Andrew. This has been a religious site since the 700s and the patrons can take you through its history from its origins right up to the present day. The Hasells have always a strong connection with the church and still own the chancel. Visitors can either drive to Dacre from Dalemain or will be provided with a leaflet to guide them on the short and picturesque walk to Dacre through the Dalemain Estates.

Marmalade Lover's Talk

Dalemain is famous nowadays for one thing in particular - marmalade! This talk provides a unique history of Britain's favourite preserve at the home of the World's Original Marmalade Awards. Including marmalade tasting, a cookery demonstration and insight into what inspired Jane Hasell-McCosh to found the now internationally renowned Marmalade Awards.
